2018 has been an exciting and productive for BFA. The spread of the G to 22 language groups in the form of printed B and audio/video messages. The J Film is presented through out S.E. Asia to new discipleship and listening groups.

The goal of 2019, is to target 2000 new G listening groups throughout seven Asian nations in dozens of languages. The sharing opportunities continue to increase in this area of the world.

The persecution of several people groups in Myanmar, Thailand, Vietnam, Laos, and China. Many are refugees and others are escaping to jungle areas and some are finding safety in churches. Among them are believers who are displaced too.
