MISSIONARY HIGHLIGHT

Swapan - India

Swapan is a native of India. Converted in his early 20s he has been on fire for the Lord ever since! He has worked extensively with GRN and other organizations. He and his wife Chandra have two grown daughters and have taken on the support and care of many family members as well as orphans. Swapan often visits remote villages that have never heard the Gospel or the name of Jesus. WMF has provided him with mini projectors so he can show Christian films, download scripture, and Christian music. WMF has also provided outreach funds and other equipment, most recently a new laptop, from Craft Sale funds. In villages where there are believers, Swapan does teaching and discipleship. With his own funds, he often purchases small gifts to take into the remote places which delight the people, many who have never seen “dollar store” type items before.

Pray for his continued outreaches and effectiveness. Pray for the terrible persecution which is occurring now in India, especially in rural areas where lawlessness reigns.
