CROSS-CULTURAL HIGHLIGHT

Ben and Burgi O

Serving with IM - Europe and the Middle East

Ben and Burgi are German nationals and have served in various areas in Eastern Europe and Europe for several decades now. A big part of their ministry is to put on Evangelistic English and Discipleship camps. One of their recent camps was in East-Germany with 65 campers from various European and African countries. The support staff was a group of volunteers from seven different nationalities. This camp was directed to teenagers who participate in English lessons, introduced to the gospel, and praise songs. The staff shares their testimonies. During the last evening, several teenagers made commitments to follow Jesus. There is a local team who will do the follow-up work, helping these new converts join a local church and discipleship.

The next camp will focus on discipleship training of 10 believers in a sensitive area of the world. The campers and staff ask for God's protection over them as they lay strong foundations in the faith. In these sensitive areas, the funding is limited, but the training is so desperately needed and considered very precious. If you would like to donate any amount, you can give to Women's Missionary Fellowship, who will forward to this ministry.

**Pray for the protection of the upcoming discipleship camp in a sensitive area.
